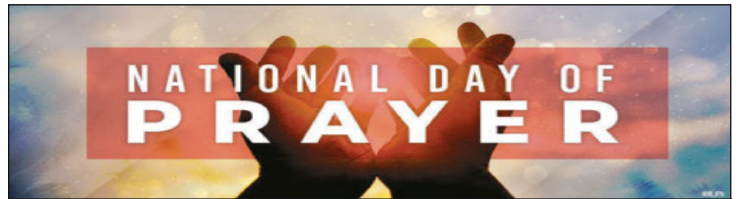


**Save The Date - Annual Family Rosary Crusade**

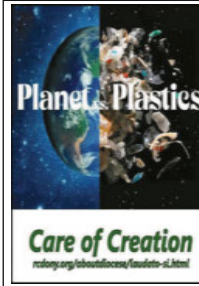
