

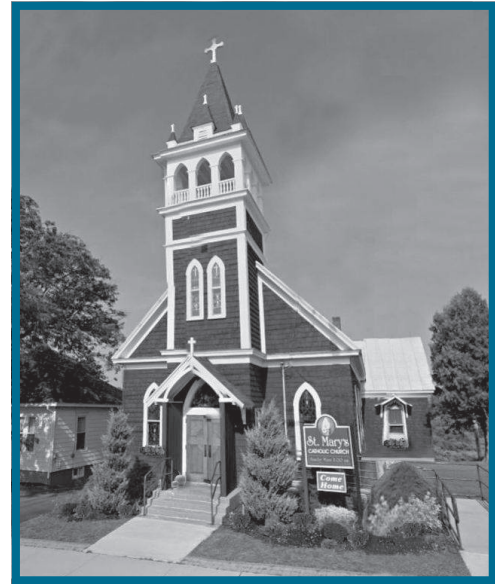

From the Pastor:

Next Sunday we will celebrate First Eucharist at St. James with a special 1pm Mass. On Saturday, May 5, there will be a very important First Eucharist rehearsal at 6:30pm in the Church for all the children and their parents. Please bring your family banner to the rehearsal.

The Parish Finance Committee met recently to assess our current financial situation and make plans for the future. Based on our present finances, it was decided to proceed with the rebuilding of the northwest turret (by the handicap ramp) this spring. As you remember, this turret has serious interior disintegration and the whole turret needs to be taken down and rebuilt. Lupini Construction began their work a few weeks ago and plans to have it completed before the St. James Fair. Unfortunately, we will not be able to afford any more exterior work until spring 2019.

After consulting with some parish groups, it was decided to ask Bishop LaValley to come to St. James to celebrate a Mass of Thanksgiving for the success of our interior renovation project. If we wait until the whole church is renovated (the interior AND exterior), I will be in a Priests' Retirement home drooling and unable to tell people my name. Therefore, the thinking has been to have a celebration now, rather than later – several years from now. Bishop LaValley has graciously accepted our invitation and has made plans in his schedule to come to St. James on Sunday, May 27 at 10am to celebrate this wonderful Mass of Thanksgiving. There will be a reception in the CAA gym following the Mass. Please mark your calendar now so you will be able to come and celebrate with us.
