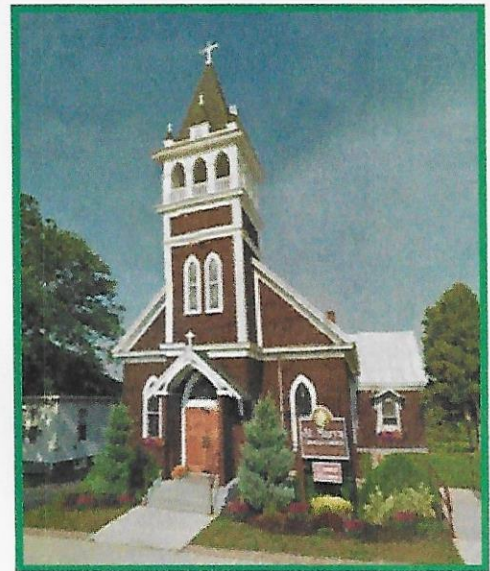

Is it possible that the summer is just about over and school is getting ready to start? I am so glad that these quiet halls are going to spring to life in a few weeks. A school without children and teachers is just a building and I am looking forward to seeing the little smiling faces, meeting all of our families, old and new and seeing our dedicated teachers arriving to set up classrooms--coffee in one hand, a big bag of classroom supplies in another! You can feel the anticipation in the air. There is just something about the beginning of the school year you never outgrow!

We have many new families this year and, of course, our families that have been with us for many years. I want to thank all of the members of this parish and community that have so generously given of your time, talent and treasure to help Augustinian Academy continue our mission of providing a Catholic Christ-centered foundation for faith formation, academic excellence and community service since 1885!

I'd like to especially thank Joe Margrey and John Ashcraft for repairing the wall down by the cafeteria. The crack is gone, a drop ceiling was added and it looks great! This is just one of the MANY things these two men do to help us here at the Academy. If you are looking for ways to help at the Academy, there are a few areas that provide some opportunities.

- **Adopt a Student:** There is a greater need now than ever for tuition assistance. Many of our families are sending more than one child to our school. Whatever you can give in this area is so appreciated and often makes the difference in parent decisions to send their children here to the Academy.
- **Adopt a Teacher**—Do you have a favorite grade level or teacher that you would like to support? Their needs are as varied as the ages and subjects they teach! Contact a teacher of your choice and ask them what they need! They would be so appreciative of your help! Or, if you'd rather, sometimes little appreciation gifts such as a coffee or a homemade treat or even an upbeat email with a funny meme goes a long way in reviving our teachers.
- **Volunteers**

- **Supplies** –We are still pretty good for school supplies, however there are some other supplies we need:
