Important Message from Pastor

As you may know from listening to the news and reading the newspaper last week, the state legislature has passed the Child Victims Act and it took effect August 14. For one year the statute of limitations that precluded victims of child sexual abuse from bringing allegations before the courts has been lifted. This new law will present special challenges to the Church and for other organizations that deal with children.

Many of those stories will challenge our consciences, and our spiritual and material resources to respond. We as a Church family cannot heal without caring for the wounded among us – the survivors, but also those who might have been falsely accused. Although all of us in the Diocese – and in the Church worldwide – will face challenges in the months ahead and may become even discouraged, know that our ministries and our mission will continue. We will be a different Church when this process is over, but we will be a better Church because of it. The truth is the only way through this, and the truth will set us free

From the Pastor:

We will have tables and chairs set up but if you would like to bring a folding chair, that would be great. The Magic Show will start promptly at noon; other children's activities will follow. Three major construction/renovation projects have begun or will commence soon on the St. James and St. Mary's campuses. I want you to be aware of them.

1. This week the new roof began to be replaced over an older section of Augustinian Academy. As you might remember, we had some significant leaks in the library and other sections of the building this past winter. Sands Bros., Antwerp is completing the work and we have been promised that the new roof will be on before the new school year begins, which is very soon.

2. The painting of the exterior of St. Mary's Church should start soon. J. Smith and Sons, Port Leyden will complete the painting and any repairs to the tower of the church. This is the same company which painted the interior of St. James Church last year.

3. On the day after Labor Day, Sept. 3, Lupini Construction, Utica will begin Phase 4 of the exterior restoration on St. James Church tower. This work entails the exterior of the top of the east elevation and both the interior and exterior of the north elevation. This exterior renovation work on St. James will probably continue until the 2nd Coming of Christ!

All this being said, and with my involvement with this construction, it doesn't look like I am going to find time to go south to help the President build his WALL along the southern border! He is going to be very disappointed.

Our faith calls us to be committed to reaching out in help to our brothers and sisters in need. This Fall, the 2019 Bishop's Fund Appeal will begin in our parishes. Join us September 18 and 19 for an overnight bus trip to Pennsylvania to see the wonderful production, Jesus, (www.sightsound.com) in Lancaster and to visit the shrines of St. John Neumann (www.stjohnneumann.org) and St. Katharine Drexel (www.katharinedrexel.org) in Philadelphia.
