From the Pastor:

We welcome Father Joseph Genito, O.S.A., to St. James and St. Mary's this weekend. Father Joe is in Carthage to visit his family and attend his school reunion. WELCOME HOME, Father!

Last week FARNEY's installed a new blue carpet in the sacristy of St. James Church (both the main sacristy and outer sacristy). It is beautiful and what an improvement to the church! I want to thank the AVES for financing this huge project. This was done in memory of Bette Champine who was a very active member of the AVES. She passed away in February and I know she would be very pleased with this new carpet. She never liked the old red one, especially with all the burn marks in it.

As some of you might remember, I lead a pilgrimage to England/Wales back in April. I displayed the photos when I returned. It was a great trip with many wonderful memories. A few parishioners have inquired where I might be going next. I am happy to announce that I will be leading a pilgrimage to Italy and the famous Passion Play of Oberammergau in May 2020.

Drawing crowds from all over the world, the PASSION PLAY of OBERAMMERGAU is a musical drama of epic dimensions and regarded as the longest running play in history. It's staged every 10 years from May to October in the small, picturesque village of Oberammergau nestled in a valley amidst Germany's Bavarian Alps. According to the story passed down through generations, as the Black Plague swept through Europe in 1633 a villager inadvertently exposed Oberammergau to the dreaded disease. After 84 people died, the survivors gathered and made a solemn oath: if God spared them, every 10 years they would present a day-long play depicting the last week in the life of Christ.

The villagers' prayers were answered; there were no more deaths. In 1634 the townspeople performed their PASSION PLAY for the first time on a stage erected over the graves of plague victims. Eventually their children and their descendants took up the vow, holding themselves responsible for the promise made by their forefathers. To this day, the villagers of Oberammergau have kept their promise virtually unbroken.

The first public performance of the PASSION PLAY will be on May 17, 2020. The modern play takes place on an open-air stage with a covered auditorium seating 4,700, against a beautiful backdrop of towering Alpine mountains. With a total cast of 1,000, the play boasts 130 speaking parts, hundreds of smaller parts. To be eligible for a role, the person must have either been born in Oberammergau or lived there 20 years.

Watching the last days of Jesus unfold before you, will leave you with renewed faith and an affirmation of the importance of HIS life and Resurrection! When the citizens of Oberammergau perform their play in the year 2020, they'll be keeping a promise made over 380 years ago. Please consider joining me on this trip of a life-time beginning May 25, 2020 – a trip to beautiful Italy, including Rome, Assisi, Florence and Venice and then to the incredible PASSION PLAY. Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ:

Fifty years ago, Pope Paul VI (now Blessed Paul VI), wrote a document called *Humanae Vitae (Of Human Life)*. It was issued amid the social turmoil of the nineteen sixties. The culture and questions described in *Humanae Vitae*, though written a half century ago, remain fresh and relevant. You might think it was written only yesterday.

The Holy Father reiterated the Church's fundamental teaching about the beauty of marriage in the face of much societal rejection. Many considered it old-fashioned and out dated, yet his words have become truly prophetic. The Pope expounded on our Catholic beliefs about human sexuality, conjugal love and responsible parenthood. His message is one of love and hope for the confusing world in which we live.

Every year, the Church participates in a national educational campaign that focuses our attention on Natural Family Planning methods. The dates of the NFP Awareness Week (July 22-28) coincide with the anniversary of the papal document. This year's theme is "*Generations of Love*" *Humanae Vitae (1968-2018) Celebrate God's Gift of Married Love!*

NFP is about giving oneself freely, totally, faithfully, and fruitfully to another person in marriage. To make oneself totally vulnerable, to sacrifice for the love of another is the heroism of the marital vocation. We need the witness of such unselfish love. All of us, married and single, need to accompany and support our parents, those who are single parents, often heroic in their love, and those who struggle in their marriage. The vision of *Humanae Vitae* can sustain them. We are grateful to the many couples who live its message, whose lives say "YES" to that sacrificial love which is open to life.

NFP ministry in the Diocese of Ogdensburg exists today because of the faith, courage, perseverance, and sacrifice of our NFP leaders. We are blessed to have Suzanne and Angelo Pietropaoli serve as our diocesan directors of Natural Family Planning.
