From the Pastor:

The second collection today is an important one: the Missionary Projects of the Diocese Collection or MPDO. The focus of the collection this year is on the Diocese of Lakakia. This Diocese in Syria has become our "twin Diocese" and Bishop Chbeir visited us this past year. The Diocese has 35,000 Catholics, living in 32 parishes and there are 28 priests serving in the Diocese. There has been a civil war in the country of Syria since 2011 and it has been very disruptive to the country's economy. It has led to much refugee migration and many refugees pour into the Diocese of Latakia and the Diocese must assist them. The Diocese spends \$15,000 per month to feed refugees at 5 camps and also supports displaced families. There are 3 major seminarians who must study in Lebanon due to the strife in Syria. Bishop Chbeir pays \$27,000 per year to educate these seminarians. Therefore, please support this very important 2nd collection for this very important cause. There is an envelope in your packet for this collection or if you do not have an envelope, you can just put a donation into the collection basket or send a donation to the parish office. THANKS!

Last week FARNEY's installed a new blue carpet in the sacristy of St. James Church (both the main sacristy and outer sacristy). It is beautiful and what an improvement to the church! Missionary zeal has always been a telling sign of the vitality of the Catholic Church. The Missionary Projects of the Diocese of Ogdensburg Appeal will also continue to be used to provide financial support of our former mission in Mollendo, Peru, support the United States Bishops' annual Appeal for Latin America, and assist other missionary projects throughout the world as part of our evangelization efforts.
