# From the Pastor:

## Welcome to Holy Week!

Today is Palm Sunday or sometimes called Passion Sunday. Palm Sunday, while still part of the Lenten season, inaugurates entrance into the liturgical year's holiest, most solemn week. Holy Week has as its purpose the remembrance of Christ's passion, beginning with His Messianic entrance into Jerusalem. Palm branches will be blessed and distributed at all the Masses this weekend. Please make sure you take a palm home and display it there. The first days of Holy Week, like all of Lent, serve as final preparation for the celebration of Easter. The so-called Easter Triduum begins with Holy Thursday and includes 3 solemn days. Please do your best to participate in these most important liturgical events. By now all the registered parishioners of St. James and St. Mary's should have received an Easter mailing from me with the Holy Week schedule included. The schedule is also printed herein. Please note that there will be Morning Prayer during the Triduum at 9am. The last Stations of the Cross will be held on Good Friday.

Next Sunday on Easter, we are asking all the children of the parishes to bring their Easter baskets to Mass for an Easter basket blessing. I have checked with the Easter Bunny and he is scheduled to leave some candies here for the children on Easter. They will be given to the children at the time of the Easter basket blessing.

Divine Mercy Sunday is April 11. We are planning our annual celebration of this important Sunday at St. James. The prayers of the Chaplet of the Divine Mercy will be held that afternoon beginning at 3pm.

I am happy to report that 100 people attended the 200<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Event – The Religious Art of St. James Church – presented by Michael Sligar. Those in attendance received a FREE booklet. Now, the booklets will be sold after Mass along with Anniversary masks and glassware.
