

World Day of Prayer for Vocations
On Good Shepherd Sunday, May 11,
2025, the Church celebrates the 62nd Anniversary of the World Day of Prayer for Vocations. Pope Francis' message to young people was sent to the world before his death into eternal life as he ex-

tended "a joyful and encouraging invitation to become pilgrims of hope by generously offering your lives as a gift."

"It is a time to seek God's guidance for those discerning His call to serve the Church. As Christ reminds us, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few" (Luke 10:2). On this sacred day, let us pray that young men and women will open their hearts to the Lord's invitation to the priesthood, diaconate, religious life, and consecrated life. May they embrace their vocations with faith, courage, and joy, answering God's call to love and serve His people."

The Diocese of Ogdensburg - is pleased to now be able to offer Naloxone training, commonly known as Narcan training, to our diocesan parishes, outreach centers and organizations. Between 2019 and 2023, 396 residents of the Diocese of Ogdensburg and neighbors died of drug overdoses. Statewide, there were 6,330 overdose deaths during that period, an average of more than 1,500 per year. Data suggests those numbers continue to climb.

As Catholics, we recognize the sanctity of life from conception to natural death, and we work to save the lives of the unborn, the affirm, the elderly - everyone. We have an opportunity to learn to save more lives with this training.

In this Year of Hope, please join me in praying for those battling the scourge of addiction and in working to love and support them in their battles.


