

## From the Pastor:

Today is Pentecost Sunday. Pentecost literally means 50th – it is a feast celebrated on the 50th day after the feast of the Resurrection of our Lord. It is regarded as the birthday of the Church. It is the Feast of the Holy Spirit. I hope you remembered to wear something red today – it is the color of the Holy Spirit. If you forgot, don't worry, we have something red to give you to wear.

Don't forget that we are honored to have Bishop LaValley with us next weekend! He will celebrate the 8am Mass at St. Mary's and then celebrate the 10am Mass at St. James. The St. James celebration is a Mass of Thanksgiving for the successful conclusion to our interior church renovation. It will be a day to rejoice and come together as a faith community to celebrate this momentous occasion. Please join us for this wonderful event! There will be a reception in the CAA gym following the Mass.

The Open House at CAA is today after the 10am Mass. This will be an opportunity for parents (and even parishioners without school age children) to visit the school and see all the good "stuff" going on at the school.

Tomorrow morning all the priests of the Diocese will head to Lake Placid for their annual convocation with the Bishop. This event is also called the Presbyteral Assembly. Therefore, there will be Communion Services in the parishes on both Tuesday and Wednesday.

The Memorial Mass and burial for Bette Shampine will be Thursday at 9am at St. James. Following the burial, there will be a small reception in the St. James Community Room. As you remember, when Bette died so tragically in early February, we had to have her funeral Mass in the CAA gym because the new tile floor was being installed in the church. So, that is why we are having this special Mass now. If I didn't have a proper Church Mass for Bette in the newly renovated St. James Church, she would come back to haunt me and I don't want that to happen.

Next Monday is Memorial Day and the St. James Cemetery Mass is scheduled for 9am that morning. I have included the Rules and Regulations for St. James Cemetery, St. Mary's Cemetery and St. Peter and Paul Cemetery in today's bulletin. As you might remember, these Rules and Regulations were revised two years ago and I want everyone to be familiar with them again. Please join us next Monday for the annual Cemetery Mass

## St. James Cemetery

You will soon notice that Bob Demers will be cleaning headstones in the New St. James Cemetery If you have a head stone that you would like cleaned, you can meet with him. Please contact 315-493-6643 to make arrangements. St. James Cemeteries - Many people have been seen in the Cemetery these last few days preparing their family burial plots for the Memorial Day celebrations. You probably remember that two years ago, the Cemetery Committee revised the Rules and Regulations which apply to all three cemeteries: St. James, St. Mary's and St. Peter and Paul. I am reprinting them again now to refresh your memory. Please adhere to these rules:

- Potted plants, flowers in flower boxes or suitable metal containers may be placed on plots for special occasions (such as Memorial Day), <u>but</u> can only remain there for a period <u>not exceeding</u> two weeks. The Cemetery personnel reserve the right to remove all flowers, wreaths or other decorations from lots as soon as they become unsightly.
- 2. Due to hazardous conditions to the caretakers when using power equipment, artificial flowers, glass or plastic flower blocks, trees, ornaments of any kind, colored stones or pebbles, candles, vigil lights, crockery jars, decorative fences, any edging, shepherd's hooks or any type of container that the Cemetery personnel deems unsuitable, will NOT be allowed on any plot at any time. One small solar light will be allowed per grave site, placed near the stone for ease of mowing.
- 3. Small flags are permitted on graves, but they must be maintained and must be removed when they become worn.
- 4. Bicycles, skateboards, snowmobiles, motorcycles, horses, etc. may not be used on Cemetery property except with the approval of the Cemetery. Dogs are not permitted except when kept on a leash or in a vehicle.
- 5. When planting flowers, etc. on a plot, all debris (old planting containers) must be removed and discarded properly.
