

Up Coming election - Proposition 1 -

Also called the "Equal Rights Amendment, "will be on the ballot for all New Yorkers during the 2024 election. It is <u>not</u> really about equal rights at all. The language is deceptive. If Prososition 1 passes, unrestricted abortion will be enshrined in the NY State constitution; children will be able to seek medical treatment (including puberty blockers and gender surgeries) without parental consent; men will be allowed in women's sports and other spaces; and Catholic institutions could be forced to support and promote sexual morality that is contrary to Catholic doctrine.
