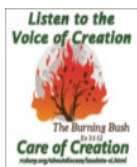

K of C News:

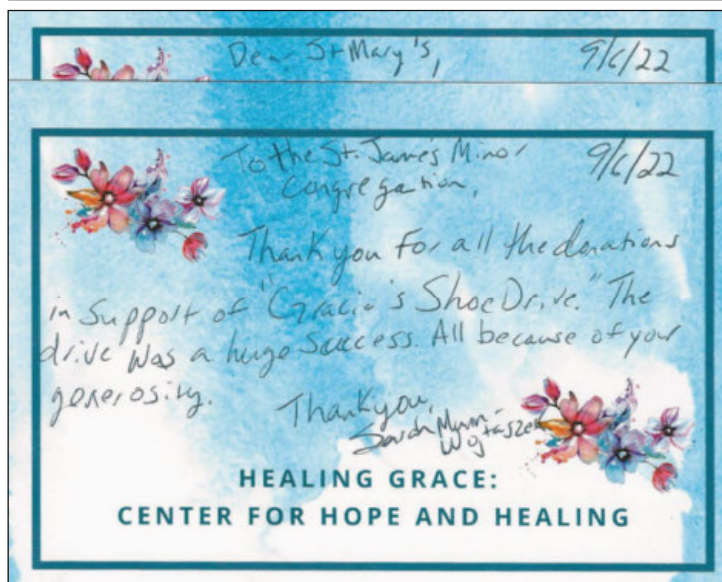
