All sessions will be held on Sunday mornings at 9am at Augustinian Academy. Students in the public school system in grades 1 thru 6 are invited and encouraged to register. Obviously, very strict safety and health procedures will be in place for these classes. Arrival guidelines, masks, social distancing, health screening and departure guidelines will be followed. Some people have told me that they are having trouble following the Mass and the sacred scripture readings without the regular hymnals in the pews. Therefore, I have placed some in the Gathering Space for you to use. However, you must take a copy and use it as your very own . In other words, you must take it home after use and bring it back each time to Mass. We are not allowed to pass the books out at random and have many different people use them.

THANKS to Rita LaBarge and her helpers who have provided St. James with beautiful flowers from her garden each week. We have really enjoyed all the wonderful flower arrangements. It has greatly contributed to the beauty of the St. James sanctuary.
