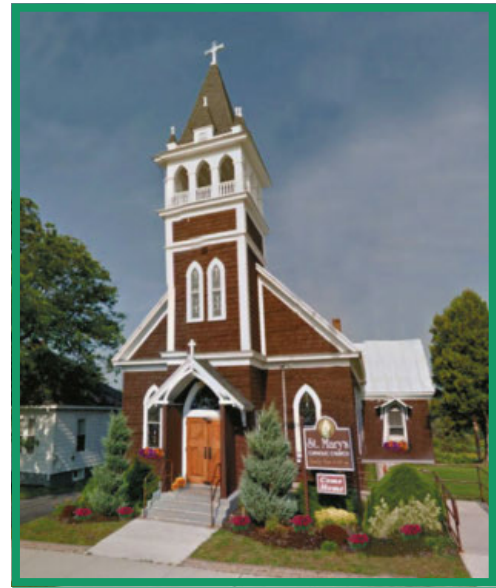

#### **Youth Leadership Retreat for Teens in Grades 9 to 12**
